**"Jesus establishment as the Son of God was officially proposed and voted on by the Council of Nicea...and a relatively close vote at that." (233)**

**Christ sure thought He was!**

**Matt 14:23; 16:15-20; 25:31-46**

**So did the Apostles**

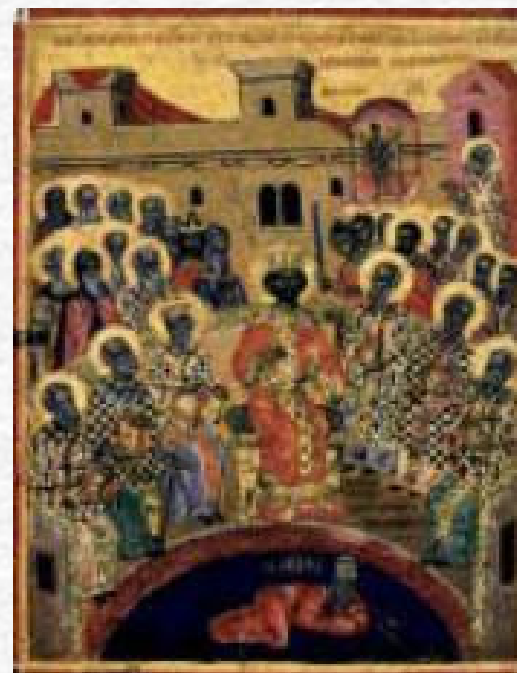
**All (but one) killed for their beliefs**

**So did the early Church Fathers**

**Ignatius: "God Himself was manifested  
in human form." AD 105**

**Clement: "It is fitting that you should  
think of Christ as of God." AD150**

**Irenaeus: "He is God, for the name  
Emmanuel indicates this." AD 180**



**Nicea was called (in part) to debate the Arian heresy (that Christ was created God).  
Only 2 of the 318 delegates voted against the creed that affirmed His eternal nature (begotten-ness.)**
